Introducing Carob Tree Funds: Donor Advised Funds for Teen Philanthropy

Q: What is a donor advised fund (DAF)? A: It's like having a "charitable checking account." Here's how:

Step 1: Open a fund, contribute donations (cash, stock, bonds, etc.) today, and earn immediate tax benefits.

Step 2: The money in this fund is professionally invested by the JCF, with the potential to grow over time.

Step 3: Recommend grants from your fund for charitable purposes whenever you're ready.

In short, with a DAF, you centralize your philanthropy, reduce paperwork, and grow your charitable dollars.

Q: What is a Carob Tree Fund? A: It's a DAF for teens, to become expert philanthropists! Here's how:

Step 1: Parent(s)/guardian(s) open a DAF for their 12-18 year-old child. This works great before a b'nai mitzvah!

Step 2: With a minimum contribution of \$250 into the fund, this donation will be matched with an additional \$50, thanks to the Barnard & Amy Kaplan Donor Advised Fund of the JCF. Other matches may be available as well.

Step 3: For each of the next three years, a \$50 charitable grant recommendation may be made to any Jewish Federation agency, day school, synagogue, or youth organization in Burlington/Camden/Gloucester counties, as long as \$150 remains in the fund. Once the fund's balance reaches \$2,500, it can be used like a normal DAF.

Wait! There's more!
